For more than 15 years Wellington-based ensemble *The Tudor Consort* has set the standard for early choral performance in New Zealand: an innovative approach to repertoire selection and interpretation, accuracy of context and presentation through the group's unique "historical reconstruction" process, and an emphasis on choral excellence through superb balance, blend and vocal technique.

The choir is made up of Wellington's finest choral musicians and is an accomplished and experienced performing unit, having given more than 50 concerts in Wellington, a dozen in other New Zealand centres and nearly 20 in international venues. Key concert repertoire for 2004 and 2005 includes classical, romantic and 20th century choral works as well as New Zealand works and, of course, the group's specialist Renaissance repertoire. This choir is admired locally, nationally and internationally as one of New Zealand's top-tier vocal groups.

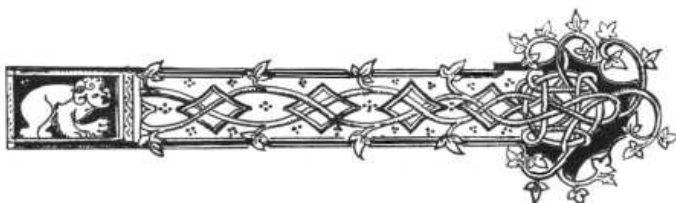
The group seeks engagements outside the Wellington region during late 2004 and calendar 2005. Concert fees can range considerably, from about \$1600-\$2600 excluding travel and accommodation expenses, because the performance is tailored to meet your specific requirements. The group has no complex pack-in/pack-out or sound gear requirements; all you need to provide is an atmospheric acoustic and this award-winning choir will take care of the rest!
